RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY WINES

In the past we have purchased outside fruit for the Russian River Valley wines, and kept all of our Estate fruit (owned and sustainably farmed entirely by Lynmar Estate in-house staff) for our Single Vineyard wines. As our Estate vineyards are now fully redeveloped, our production of top-quality fruit has increased. We are now producing our Russian River Valley wines largely from our own Estate vineyards.

While our single vineyard Quail Hill Vineyard wines are cellar worthy and benefit from decanting, the Russian River wines are immediately enjoyable with a good swirl in the glass. They capture the bright, fresh fruit and the distinctive structure of Russian River Valley wines, plus a layer of complexity from the estate terroir. These qualities make them delicious wines to pair with vibrant cuisines and fresh ingredients at the table in your home or in your favorite restaurant.



Russian River Valley Chardonnay, 2021

The 2021 Russian River Valley Estate Chardonnay is tended to with the same meticulous care we bring to our Pinot Noir. Every vine is hand-picked and cared for by our full time vineyard team. This cuvée is comprised entirely of Rued clone from Quail Hill. The uniqueness of Quail Hill Vineyard contributed to the dynamic character of our Russian River Valley Chardonnay. Originally planted in 1976 on Saint George rootstock, the Rued clone exudes vibrant acidity and exotic aromatics while providing a focused and generous mouthfeel.

Russian River Valley Pinot Noir, 2019

The 2019 Russian River Valley Pinot Noir is the quintessential expression of the Russian River AVA. Consisting primarily of our three estate vineyards; Adam's, Quail Hill and Susanna's, this cuvée showcases the best of what the appellation has to offer. Meticulous farming practices and detail oriented winemaking go into each bottle produced. Each vineyard component adds its own nuance and complexity to the blend resulting in a stunning wine that is greater than the sum of its parts.
