



## 2018 Kanzler Vineyard Pinot Noir

The 2018 Kanzler Vineyard Pinot Noir is comprised of three distinctive clones: 667, 115, and Pommard. The vineyard is oriented on an eastern facing slope with its vines deeply rooted in Goldridge sandy loam soil. A saturated crimson in color the 2018 Kanzler Pinot Noir emits intense notes of fresh blueberry, lavender, crushed herbs, and cola. An opulent entry on the palate gives way to tastes of cranberry cocoa powder and sarsaparilla which transition to silky tannins on the finish with reminiscing hints of blueberry and crushed herbs.
