



2018 Monastery Pinot Noir

Crafted with a careful selection of Pinot Noir clones, our Monastery release is a nod to the wines of Burgundy. With an inherently earthy, savory character, this age-worthy wine's velvet richness is tempered by higher acidity and oak influences. A saturated ruby color gives way to bright cherry aromas, intertwined with savory hints of pink peppercorn, tar and crushed herbs. Notes of baked blueberries, cocoa powder and fresh tobacco carry through the palate, framed with bright acidity and faint tastes of citrus zest. The persistent finish culminates with savory flavors of star anise, clove and black tea.
