RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY WINES

In the past we have purchased outside fruit for the Russian River Valley wines, and kept all of our Estate fruit (owned and sustainably farmed entirely by Lynmar Estate in-house staff) for our Single Vineyard wines. As our Estate vineyards are now fully redeveloped, our production of top-quality fruit has increased. We are now producing our Russian River Valley wines largely from our own Estate vineyards.

While our single vineyard Quail Hill Vineyard wines are cellar worthy and benefit from decanting, the Russian River wines are immediately enjoyable with a good swirl in the glass. They capture the bright, fresh fruit and the distinctive structure of Russian River Valley wines, plus a layer of complexity from the estate terroir. These qualities make them delicious wines to pair with vibrant cuisines and fresh ingredients at the table in your home or in your favorite restaurant.



Russian River Valley Chardonnay, 2013

The 2013 Russian River Valley Chardonnay is made up of 100% estate fruit from Quail Hill, Susanna's and Sweeney vineyards. This Chardonnay is a blend of clones 4, Rued and Old Wente. The 2013 growing season consisted of a warm and dry spring that brought near ideal growing conditions, which allowed the grapes to achieve optimal maturity.

Russian River Valley Pinot Noir, 2014

The 2014 Russian River Valley Pinot Noir is comprised of 88% estate fruit from the Quail Hill and Susanna's properties. The balance of the blend is sourced from the renowned Kanzler Vineyard. In 2014 the growing season got off to an early start. Moderately warm weather throughout the summer allowed the grapes to reach desired physiological ripeness and maintain excellent quality.
