



2018 Old Vines Pinot Noir

The 2018 Old Vines Pinot Noir was crafted from heritage vines of Swan clone planted in 1974 on Saint George rootstock at Quail Hill. A deep garnet color in the glass leads to classic Swan clone aromatics of fresh red fruits, with ripe Bing cherry and pomegranate supported by graphite and sage undertones. An opulent but focused mouthfeel evoke flavors of cedar, Santa Rosa plum and hints of clove which transition seamlessly into fine grained tannins and an elongated finish.
