



2015 Old Vines Chardonnay

Perhaps the most unique Chardonnay in the Lynmar Estate collection, this wine is crafted from the Rued Clone from 40-year-old heritage vines on a single block of Quail Hill Vineyard. We begin with a 24-hour cold soak on the skins, before pressing off the juice, adding intriguing layers of texture and nuance. A bright golden hue, aromas of fresh yellow peach, lychee, honeysuckle, Buddha's hand and lemon emerge from the glass. The viscous, round entry brings beeswax, lanolin, orange citrus peel, mango and papaya notes into play. The skin contact during the cold soak adds unusual texture and weight to the long, pithy finish. Enjoy upon release through 2022.
