



2015 Old Wente Chardonnay

To craft this release, we isolate the Old Wente clone from blocks on both the Quail Hill and Susanna's estate vineyard sites. Considered the “grandfather clone” of California Chardonnay, Old Wente displays gorgeous intensity and focused acidity on each of these cool properties. A vivid golden hue in the glass, look for bright aromas of Gravenstein apple, lemongrass, crushed flint, brioche and vanilla bean. The focused entry is marked by bright acidity and vivid notes of lime zest tempered by lemon balm and pie crust. The acidity carries through into the long finish, with a final reverberation of vanilla bean. Drink upon release through 2023.
