



## 2015 Old Vines Pinot Noir

Celebrating the history, terroir and heritage of Pinot Noir in the Russian River Valley, we craft this release from heritage vines of the Swan clone, planted in 1974 on St. George's rootstock in our Quail Hill Vineyard Estate. A deep ruby with a blushing rose rim, intriguing aromas of dark cherry, sassafras, rose water and tangerine peel emerge from the glass. On the plush palate, flavors of raspberry, cassis and fresh sage join in. A long, textured finish is brightened by fresh cranberry and cinnamon notes. Enjoy this release between 2018-2022.
