



2016 Old Vines Pinot Noir

The 2016 Old Vines Pinot Noir was crafted from heritage vines of Swan clone planted in 1974 on Saint George rootstock at Quail Hill. Dark garnet in color, this wine showcases aromas of cranberry, dark cherry, apple skin and birch bark. A supple entry on the palate transitions into notes of cinnamon, fresh herbs, clove and red currant. Bright acidity on the palate leads to fine tannins that carry notes of star anise and tangerine peel.
