



## 2016 Adam's Vineyard Chardonnay

Adam's Vineyard is the newest addition to our estate portfolio. Planted in 2013, this 9-acre site is warmer than both Quail Hill and Susanna's, adding a unique Russian River Valley climate profile to our collection. A glorious golden color in the glass, this wine showcases aromas of pear, baked apple, lemon zest and hints of fennel. The rich palate entry leads into bright flavors of peach and lemon oil, balanced with wet stone and brioche. A persistent finish culminates with notes of cantaloupe, citrus rind and wet stone.
