



2016 Kanzler Vineyard Pinot Noir

The 2016 Kanzler Vineyard Pinot Noir is comprised of three clones: 667, 115, and Pommard. The vineyard is oriented on an eastern facing slope with its vines deeply rooted in Goldridge sandy loam soil. A dark ruby hue emerges from the glass. Notes of plum, violet, elderberry and forest floor envelop the senses. A plush, soft entry leads to notes of cherry cola, blueberry and dried herbs. The palate expands further giving flavors of cranberry, Rainier cherry and black tea which culminates with lingering tannins on the finish.
