



2016 Monastery Pinot Noir

Crafted with a careful selection of Pinot Noir clones, our Monastery release is a nod to the wines of Burgundy. With an inherently earthy, savory character, this age-worthy wine's velvet richness is tempered by higher acidity and oak influences. A dark ruby color, the 2016 Monastery Pinot Noir exudes aromas of ripe strawberry, pink peppercorn, citrus rind and herbs de Provence. The expansive entry gives way to tastes of baked rhubarb, red apple skin, fresh cranberry with hints of baking spice and flint. A textured finish with fine tannins echoes flavors of peppercorn and strawberry.
