



2016 Susanna's Vineyard Pinot Noir

A gift from our Proprietor to his wife, Susanna's Vineyard is a stunning 20-acre site along Highway 116 in Sebastopol. Though just two miles from Quail Hill, the climate is surprisingly cooler, offering a dynamic counterpoint within the Lynmar collection of wines. The vineyard site lends itself to an elegant feminine expression, with subtle red-fruit character and distinct floral aromatics. A dark ruby color in the glass, the 2016 vintage displays bright aromas of blueberry compote, dark cherry, graphite and lavender. On the palate flavors of cola, sage, birch bark, redcurrant and rose water emerge. A soft, plush mouthfeel leads way to a long finish highlighted by supple tannins and balanced structure.
