



2017 Block 10 Pinot Noir

Our Block 10 release brings together two Dijon clones – 667 & 777 – grown in a single, extreme east-facing block of our Quail Hill Vineyard estate. A vivid rich crimson color in the glass precedes aromas of black cherry, cassis, magnolia flower and fresh twig. Bright acidity on the palate leads to tastes of confectionery strawberry, teaberry, tangerine zest and lavender. The vibrant acidity carries throughout the textured finish, reminiscing with hints of black cherry and cassis.
