



2017 Kanzler Vineyard Pinot Noir

The 2017 Kanzler Vineyard Pinot Noir is comprised of three distinctive clones: 667, 115, and Pommard. The vineyard is oriented on an eastern facing slope with its vines deeply rooted in Goldridge sandy loam soil. A saturated crimson hue emerges from the glass. Bright initial aromatics of blueberry compote, fresh sage and forest floor are immediately pronounced. Silky tannins on the palate bring forth hints of black tea, star anise and cranberry skin. The plush mouthfeel carries through with a lengthy finish highlighting flavors of blueberry and crushed herbs.
