



2017 Old Vines Pinot Noir

The 2017 Old Vines Pinot Noir was crafted from heritage vines of Swan clone planted in 1974 on Saint George rootstock at Quail Hill. A saturated garnet color in the glass, this bottling of Swan clone showcases bright notes of cherry kirsch, cranberry skin, graphite and cinnamon bark. A rich but focused entry on the palate has inviting flavors of pomegranate, raspberry, forest floor and cedar. Tastes of pomegranate and cedar carry on through the persistent finish that lingers well after the last sip.
