



2017 Summit Block Pinot Noir

This distinctive wine is crafted from the Calera Pinot Noir clone planted on the summit of Quail Hill Vineyard, where Goldridge soil sits over a layer of deep red clay. A vibrant dark crimson color shows immediately in the glass. Fresh aromatics of red raspberry, cherry kirsch, boysenberry and rosemary envelop the senses. A plush entry on the palate gives way to flavors of rose water, cinnamon, red apple skin and Santa Rosa plum. Fine tannins add texture and length to the seamless finish.
