



2018 Summit Block Pinot Noir

This distinctive wine is crafted from the Calera Pinot Noir clone planted on the summit of Quail Hill Vineyard, where Goldridge soil sits over a layer of deep red clay. A saturated garnet color in the glass, this wine emits vibrant aromas of rose hips, ripe Santa Rosa plum, dried herbs and candied cherries. An opulent entry on the palate brings forth flavors of raspberry compote, crème de cassis and hints of baker's chocolate. This wine culminates on the finish with textured tannins and reminiscing hints of plum and raspberry.
