

# ADAM'S VINEYARD

Named for their son Adam, Lynn and Anisya established this special vineyard as an extension of their dedication to crafting exceptional wine. Nestled in Forestville, Adam's Vineyard represents the third and most intimate Estate site. Meticulously chosen for its unique microclimate, this 10-acre ranch was planted in 2013 to a thoughtfully curated selection of three Pinot Noir clones and two Chardonnay clones intended to match its warmer temperatures. With breathtaking views that grace the landscape, Adam's often serves as the bellwether for the harvest season, its earlier ripening grapes signaling the official start of a momentous time.

## CLIMATE & SOIL

Just under 13 miles from the Pacific Ocean, Adam's Vineyard enjoys long coastal summer days. The climate promotes optimal hang time for the grapes, leading to complex flavors, balanced acidity, and even ripening. Even during droughts, the annual rainfall at Adam's is sufficient to nourish the shallow Goldridge sandy loam soil, allowing us to minimize supplemental irrigation – a sustainable approach that honors the natural environment. Perched atop a ridge, the topsoil depth provides optimal conditions for healthy root development, balanced vine growth, and optimal flowering and berry development.
